Therapies offered are Yog, Ayurved, Naturopathy, Singi, Acupuncture, Medicated food & liquids, Fasting and Yagya. Lectures will be on physical & mental health, well-being & lifestyle.



Registration for Participating in the Events at VVK

- 1. Please register for Health Camp by scanning QR code.
- 2. Participants may contribute generously to the common causes of Vedic Vidya Kendra of their own will.
- 3. Participants are expected to maintain the decorum & follow the rules of Vedic Vidya Kendra during their stay.
- 4. Accommodation available in Individual Rooms & Shared Dormitories (separate ones for Men & Women)
- 5. While there are options to attend the camp for 1 or 3 days as well, participants are encouraged to attend for 8 days (entire duration of the camp) for effective improvement. 1 or 3 days will give an introductory experience.







Treatments being offered in the camp

- Yog Shatkarm : Yogic cleansing techniques—Neti, Basti, Nauli, Tratak, and Kapalabhati—used to purify internal organs and prepare the body for higher yogic practices.
- Ayurveda Panchkarma : A five-fold detox process—Vamana (emesis), Virechana (purgation), Basti (enema), Nasya (nasal cleansing) and Raktamokshana (bloodletting)—to remove deep-rooted toxins.
- Ayurveda Shirodhara : Warm herbal oil streamed over the forehead to relax the nervous system and support mental clarity.
- Ayurveda Enema : Medicated enema therapy that cleanses the colon and balances Vata dosha.
- Ayurvedic Massage : Therapeutic massages using herbal oils to enhance circulation, relieve stress and nourish tissues.
- Naturopathy Steam Bath : Induce sweating to eliminate toxins and ease muscular tension.
- Naturopathy Applying Multani Mitti : A natural clay pack used to cool the body and improve skin health.
- Acupuncture/Accupressure: Insertion of fine needles at specific points to balance energy and relieve pain.
- Singi Therapy: Application of suction cups to remove impure blood and improve circulation, especially for skin and joint issues.
- Medicated Food : Healthy Food and a Balanced diet will be provided.
- Consultation with Dr. : Vaidya will prescribe the treatment relevant for each participant basis their specific health condition.

It is a residential campus that organises short and long-term programs for development of students, youth and adults, basis Vedic knowledge systems. Its objective is to bring the Vedic Knowledge Systems to learning and application of all sections of the society. It has a Gurukul, Saadhak Ashram, Digital Centre and camping facilities for different age groups.

Terms and Conditions

1. Participation in Yog, Yagya & Dhyan (5:15 am to 8:00 am & 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm) is free. Anyone can participate in it.

2. Below given are the minimum contribution for health camp to cover the minimal cost of treatment, food & stay. Voluntary contributions from participants over and above the minimum is welcome!

Accommodation	8 Days/ Full camp	Three Days	One Day
Room with double occupancy	Rs. 30,000	Rs. 13,500	Rs. 4,500
Room with Single occupancy	Rs. 20,000	Rs. 9,000	Rs. 3,000

- The above contributions include the cost of treatment as prescribed by the Vaidya, consultation and consumables.
- Children (below 12 years) can accompany parents in rooms/ dormitories at an extra cost of Rs. 4,000 for the duration of the camp. They can participate in Yoga, Yagya and lectures, but will not be able to take any treatment.
- Local Puducherry participants, not staying in the campus, can attend the camp from morning (5:00 am to 9:00 pm) against a daily contribution of Rs. 750 towards treatment & meals. They will be provided a dormitory bed to take rest during the day.
- Those who wish to leave after the Yagya (in morning) or after Meditation (in evening) can buy on-spot food coupons for breakfast & dinner @ Rs. 75/ meal.
- 3. 20 % of the total amount to be paid (online) as advance for confirmation of booking, remaining payable at the time of check-in.
- 4. Cancellation policy: **Rs. 1,000** cancellation fee per participant if cancelled until **10th Jul 2025**. **Rs. 2,000** cancellation fee per participants if cancelled until **16th Jul 2025**. No refund thereafter.
- 5. To experience complete health benefits, it is advisable to attend health camp for full duration.
- 6. Participants are expected to get their own towel and toiletries for use in their own rooms. They will also be available on a chargeable basis.
- 7. **Checkin/ checkout time:** Participants are advised to check-in on 17th July, latest by 6:00 pm. Participants can leave on 25th July after lunch (by around 2:00 pm).
- 8. Participants are supposed to be healthy enough to walk to their rooms/ treatment site on their own. Elevators and ramps are available. If they require support for movement within the campus, then they need to be accompanied by a family member who can take care of them.
- 9. Participants are advised to upload their medical summary during online registration and bring their complete medical report to the camp. They will also bring the medicines they are taking in normal course and declare them to the Vaidya.
- 10. Participants will not be allowed to take home-cooked or outside food to the campus during the camp. However, if they are having any specific dietary requirement for treatment purposes, they may state them during the time of registration. Suitable exception may be done for them.
- 11. Participants are expected to follow the routine and discipline of VVK. They should remain focused on their health and well-being (as against their business, profession or entertainment).
- 12. If anyone requires support for travelling to/ from Chennai, they can reach out @ our email/ phone.

13. If participants wish to sight-see Puducherry, taxis or mini-vans, can be arranged in second half of 25th July on chargeable basis. Participants can stay back in VVK on 25th & check out on 26th morning, at no extra cost.
